Big Red begged his Mommy “Please, please, please can we?” Mommy Red said, “Yes!”

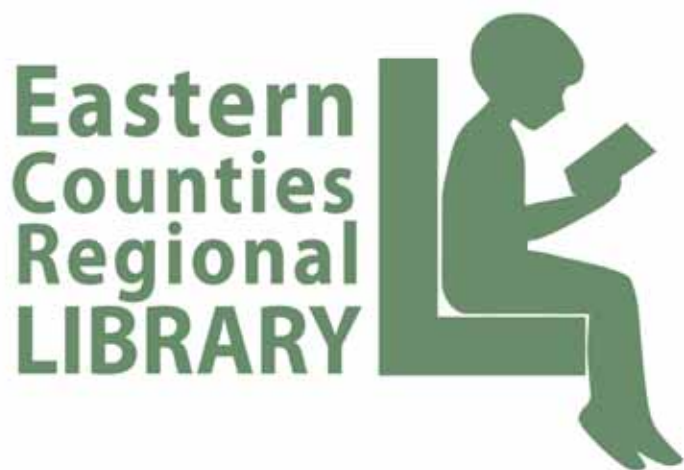
After Supper Big Red said, “We’re going to be the best of friends Teefroggie.”
